9:30 Worship | Jan 18th, 2026| Acts 2.1-41

Happy MLK weekend! In worship we've begun a new sermon series in the Book of Acts called 'Acts of the Spirit: The Church Becoming Like Jesus.'

It's never been easy for me to hold on to the nature and work of the Holy Spirit (called Comforter, Counselor, Advocate, Spirit of Truth).

My pastor from years ago, Earl Palmer, offered this definition for the Spirit: 'God invisible, personally present, bringing to completion all that Christ began.' The Spirit of Christ keeps expanding the kingdom of Jesus.

Acts tells the story of how early believers, propelled by the Spirit, continued the mission of Jesus to expand his kingdom.

We read their story with attentive care because their story and mission have become our own – even as we see and celebrate in the kingdom-expanding ministry of the Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Prayer: Lord, we ask that by the power of your Spirit, you might continue the mission of Jesus today – both to us, and through us. Amen.
