9:30 Worship | Jan 25th, 2026| Acts 2.41-47

Jesus offers the thesis sentence for the Book of Acts: 'You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'

Paraphrase: God will empower you, apprentices, to embody Jesus in the arenas of your influence. And the good news will spread from person to person like the ripples from a rock tossed into a pond.

The 'you' part is plural. Together. In community. 'You' will bear witness. 'You' will embody Jesus. How?

Acts 2.42 offers a vision of what Church can be: 'They devoted themselves to the truth of Christ, to Christ-centered relationships of depth, to sharing meals that feast on Christ, and to prayer practices that open hearts to Christ.'

The kind of community we ourselves long for most becomes good news for everyone.

Prayer: *Lord, how we do long to enjoy a meaningful spiritual life, an authentic community, and a purpose as large as your Love! Show us your Way to the Acts 2 Church. Amen.*
