When someone holds a sign on a street corner asking for help, do you find yourself tempted to look away?

When Peter encounters a man crippled on his mat asking for help, he doesn't offer money.

But notice what he invites: Looking intently at him, he invites the man to look into his eyes.

Why, do you think?

When Jesus heals a person suffering leprosy, he touches him. When Peter heals in Jesus' name a person suffering lameness, he looks into his eyes.

It would seem there's more to the healing and wholeness of Jesus than being made physically well.

Prayer: Lord, as I apprentice myself to you, transform my fearful habits. Give me the courage to risk an intimacy that heals. Amen.

Ash Wednesday Worship: Wednesday, February 18th, 5:30pm, Sanctuary

Ash Wednesday marks our entrance into Lent, a 40-day season of spiritual renewal that invites us to slow down, tell the truth about our lives, and turn again toward God's mercy in the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ. On Ash Wednesday we are marked with a cross of dust and ashes as the honest sign of our humanity and hope: from dust we have come; to Christ we will return. Come join us to sing, pray, reflect, and be marked as His beloved.

Welcome Baskets: Help Restock the Shelves!

As families from Family Promise or the Housing Advocate Network "graduate" into homes of their own, each receive appropriately sized housewarming gifts of necessary supplies needed to reestablish home life. In 2025, 44 deliveries were made. Donations of cleaning supplies, basic kitchen items, toiletry and bathroom supplies, and food staples are needed. This time we would like to focus on specific items that are needed.

Cleaning Basket: Broom and dustpan, Toilet brush and plunger set, All purpose cleaner, laundry detergent (prefer free and clear), Dish soap, 33 gallon garbage bags, Laundry baskets

Kitchen Supply Basket: Cutting Boards, Can openers, Ziplocks - gallon, quart, and sandwich, Toaster, Kitchen garbage bins (10-13 gallon)

Toiletry/Bathroom Basket: Shampoo and conditioner, Deodorant (prefer non fragrant), Body lotion (prefer non fragrant), Liquid hand soap, Small bathroom waste paper basket

Food Staple Basket: Salt and pepper, Ketchup, Mustard, Mayonnaise, Cooking oil, Pancake mix, Pancake syrup

Gift Cards & Gas Cards: \$50 gas cards, \$50 Gift cards
